When should I begin the process?

There are different timelines for each sport, division level and programs when it comes to recruitment, however AC College Recruitment sets a general recruiting timeline based on the advice of the NCAA which states that YEAR 9 is the best time to start.

It is important to note that if you aren't 100% sure if you want to compete at a US University, or aren't aware of this pathway until later in your final year of school, it is of course okay to start the process at any stage!

+ How do I know if I'm eligible?

Through a free consultation, we assess your academic and athletic achievements in order to determine this.

What colleges do you work with?

We can get in contact with any school and don't have any special arrangements with specific universities. However, we will determine which schools you will be eligible for before contacting them.



What can I study in the USA?

You are able to choose any degree you want! Medicine, education, communications, dentistry etc. and we will always guarantee finding you a university that offers the degree you wish to pursue.

Will my degree be recognised outside of the USA?

YES!

For the most part, all degrees are recognised internationally, with some course exceptions which also depend on the country you want to use the degree in.

For example, if you want to study education in the USA and plan to return home to Australia to teach there are bridging courses that you will need to complete and pass before being allowed to teach.

Will I receive a full-ride scholarship?

Full-ride scholarships are very competitive, so this depends on your athletic ability and your academics. We tell all families they should expect to pay approximately US \$15,000 per year. If you qualify, we also work to get you an academic scholarship, so the cost is further reduced.



What support is available to me once I am in the USA?

AC College Recruitment provides ongoing care throughout your entire stay in the USA. This means that we can assist you with any concerns, visa issues, university transfers, injuries, or any other concern you may have.

Additionally, the USA Collegiate System is well equipped to provide support to student-athletes. There are academic advisors, tutors, athletic faculty, and foreign student services available to you as well as your coaches and medical staff.

Is there a difference between College and University?

The terms college and university are used interchangeably in the USA, leading to a lot of confusion! To put it simply, colleges don't offer anything above a bachelor's degree while universities offer postgraduate degrees as well as a bachelor's degree.

Do you go through interview tips before speaking to coaches?

Absolutely. Once you arrange a zoom or call with a coach, we send you a list of questions to ask, common questions coaches ask, and research tips. You're free to ask us as many questions as you need so you can be fully prepared for your interview.



What if I get injured in the USA?

Injuries are to be expected with all athletes and coaches understand this. Any injury you sustain while competing or training in a school session will be covered by your international health insurance and the school's insurance.

There are full-time medical staff available at universities including doctor's, athletic trainers (physiotherapists), dentists and nurses. Please note, each university has different medical staff available and the above may not be found at all universities.

→ What happens if I don't like my university or the USA?

We offer athletes the chance to transfer universities if they don't like their initial university for any reason.

If you are feeling homesick or simply don't feel like the USA is the right pathway for you, you are able to return home at anytime.

What do you take into consideration when searching for colleges?

A few of the main things we take into consideration include: What you want to study, your high school GPA and/or grades, SAT or ACT score, what sport you will be playing, school size preference and your budget.



What are my chances of getting a scholarship?

We have a 100% success rate, so if you are successful in your initial assessment, there is a strong probability that you will receive offers for a scholarship.

We also offer a guarantee that if no scholarship is offered, due to our inability to find one, a full refund is provided. More information on this policy can be found in our Terms and Conditions.
